

ADMISSIONS POLICY

Candidates seeking admission to Brillantmont International School should :

Stage 1

- Complete the application form found in the back of the school's prospectus or website, and return it, duly signed to the school.
- Pay the registration fee in order to open the admission procedure

Stage 2

- Complete and return the
 - Parent Questionnaire
 - Student / Parent Questionnaire
 - Principal / Counselor Questionnaire completed by the candidate's present school
 - Medical Health Form

and send,

- official School Reports for the past three years
- Graded English writing sample

Stage 3

In addition

High School :

- Candidates who wish to enter the 10th grade and take the official IGCSE examination at the end of the year will be considered for admission if they have successfully completed
 - the British Programme in Year 10
 - an educational system, other than British, which is recognised as being equivalent in standard to a Year 10 British programme of studies and, in the case of candidates whose mother-tongue is not English, have attained an IELTS score of 6.0 or its equivalent.
- Candidates, whose first language is not English, and who wish to enter the 11th grade are required to prove that they have reached an intermediate level in English. The following official test scores are accepted as proof :
 - ELTiS of 220 or above
 - IELTS score of 6.0 or above
 - ibTOEFL score of 61 or above
- It is inadvisable for candidates to change schools in their final year. However, in exceptional circumstances, we will consider candidates for our 12th grade. Candidates, whose first language is not English, are required to prove that they have reached a high intermediate level in English. Only the following official test scores are accepted as proof :
 - IELTS score of 6.5 or above
 - ibTOEFL score of 79 or above



- Candidates who wish to take the A Level Programme will be considered for admission to the AS year if they have successfully completed
 - the British Programme in Year 11 and obtained a minimum of five (1)GCSE's with grades C or above, all at the extended level
 - an educational system, other than British, and obtained a national school leaving certificate which is recognised as being equivalent in standard to the (1)GCSE and, in the case of candidates whose mother-tongue is not English, have attained an
 - ibTOEFL test score of 100 or above
 - IELTS score of 7.0 or above
- It is inadvisable for candidates to change schools in their final year. However, in exceptional circumstances, we will accept qualified candidates for the "A2" year.

Special Needs :

- The school does not discriminate against students with a physical handicap. However, due to the nature of our school buildings, candidates with a physical handicap are asked to contact the school prior to completing the application form to ensure that we will be able to accommodate their individual needs.
- Whilst the school can accommodate students with mild learning disabilities, we do not have a Special Needs Specialist nor a Support Unit in the school. Candidates with specific learning disabilities are asked to include any reports documenting their individual needs with their application file, so that we can determine if a suitable programme can be offered.
- Students of exceptionally high ability and/or exceptional talent are asked to include any reports documenting their individual needs with their application file, so that we can determine if a suitable programme can be offered.

Although an interview is not required, we recommend that every prospective student tries to visit the school. In certain circumstances, the school will request that a prospective student comes for an interview.
