The Winter Course at <u>Brillantmont International School</u> in <u>Lausanne</u> is the ideal place to spend a period abroad, following High School classes, learning or improving French and joining excursions and ski trips in the beautiful <u>Lake Geneva region</u>.

Winter Course students live on the Brillantmont campus, which is in the heart of Lausanne, a dynamic, lively city, well known for being the Olympic Capital. Lausanne is on the lakeside, overlooking the Alps and has many cinemas, excellent sports facilities, theatres, shops and cafes, which appeal to the students. The Brillantmont campus is a five minute walk from the city centre, in a leafy suburb. During the school year beautiful buildings are home to around 130 students from over 35 different nationalities. The Winter Course students live and study alongside those school year students, making friendships which last a lifetime. At all times the student's safety and security are paramount and Brillantmont's teaching and boarding staff ensure that everyone feels happy and settled in the Brillantmont family.

The Winter Course begins on Sunday 7th January 2018 and lasts for 6 weeks. Students have the option to stay for a 7th week and participate in our Ski Week which is in Zinal, a traditional Swiss ski resort which has 120km of slopes for all levels.

Ski or snowboarding excursions (on Sundays) and / or additional excursions that are offered during that period (example, cinema, theatre, events)	Lessons are given by teachers from the <u>Swiss Ski School</u> . A different ski resort is chosen each Sunday, depending on snow conditions. In the event of adverse weather conditions, an alternative excursion will be organised.



WINTER COURSE 2018: FEES

Admission Deposit : CHF 1'000	The admission deposit confirms the student's place on the Winter Course. It is used to cover any additional costs such as personal expenses and any extra activities / excursions which are not included in the programme. A financial statement details this expenditure and any remaining balance is refunded at the end of the student's stay. In case of cancellation, the Admission Deposit will not be refunded.
Fees for a 6 week stay : CHF 12'000	Sunday 7th January to Saturday 17th February 2018
Fees for a 7 week stay: CHF 13'850	Sunday 7th January to Saturday 24th February 2018 (including ski week)
The above prices include :	 Accommodation and full board Academic and sports classes Ski excursions (including the lessons given by the Swiss ski school) and /or other excursions that take place Ski or snowboard rental Transfer to and from Geneva Airport on arrival and departure days Health and accident insurance
Pocket money:	Weekly pocket money may be distributed to students by the school. The school recommends a sum between CHF.50–100 per week. Parents must indicate the amount of pocket money they wish to give their child and make this sum available to the school.
Payment terms :	The fees must be paid in full before 1st December 2017.
