After School Period 1 = House. Each student belongs to one of five houses – Piccard, Rousseau, Chaplin, Anker, Einstein. The houses are student led and meet weekly to team build and play inter-house competitions.

The clubs written on the schedule are for indication only. Winter Course students are able to participate in all the after school clubs on offer.

Winter Course 2022 : excursions

During the week, the student joins two excursions to discover the local area. Places explored may include the Cathedral, the old town, the lake area, the Olympic Museum, Vevey / Montreux, the Cailler chocolate factory. During the student's stay, there will be a day trip to Geneva and to Berne. This may take place on the Saturday, depending on the programme.

Winter Course 2022 : skiing & snow

Brillantmont is around 1 hour from the nearest ski slopes. A whole day ski trip takes place on a Sunday (or sometimes on a Saturday). The ski resorts visited may include places like Gstaad, Portes du Soleil, Villars, Verbier however the decision regarding destination is taken based on weather, snow and above all, safety conditions. Students ski in small groups, based on their ability, with qualified ski teachers. They are not allowed to ski alone for safety reasons. They return to school at the end of the day.
